



NSW – ACT team have been working with the Department of Education, as well as State Training to offer bricklaying Try- a-Trade programs to secondary school students through Regional Industry Education Partnerships (RIEP). These have mainly been in the Western/South Western suburbs and Illawarra.



School presentations and other community-based programs are also proving valuable in getting our industry front and centre with career teachers and potential apprentices. We also currently working with the new School Based Apprentice officers to promote bricklaying and source additional candidates for school-based apprenticeships.
